

Nutritionist – WIC

Sullivan County Public Health Services is seeking to fill a vacancy for Nutritionist. This is a professional position involving responsibility for planning, implementing and evaluating a nutrition education program for participants in a County public health program for pregnant, postpartum and breast-feeding women and parents or caretakers of infants and children (WIC Program). A substantial part of incumbent's duties shall include working with program participants in providing nutrition education services and breastfeeding education/support. Work is performed under general supervision, with wide leeway for using independent judgment in accomplishing program objectives.

- (A) Minimum qualifications: Either: Possession of a license or certification to practice as a Registered Dietitian Nutritionist (RD/RDN); or
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with possession of a Bachelor's Degree, Master's Degree or PhD in Nutrition or Dietetics.

Special Requirement: All nutritionists must complete 24 hours of continuing education requirements every three years.
