

Sullivan County Department of Public Health Services is seeking a
PUBLIC HEALTH OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST

This is a professional position involving responsibility for evaluating, planning and providing occupational therapy treatment on an outpatient basis. The Occupational Therapist is responsible for providing Occupational Therapy to Certified Home Health Agency patients, Long Term Care patients, Early Intervention and Preschool Special Education children authorized to receive these services. Outpatient services are provided in accordance with an established interdisciplinary treatment plan, EI children's IFSPs or Preschool Special Education children's IEPs. Work is performed under general direction of the Director of Patient Services and/or a Supervising Public Health Nurse with wide leeway for independently performing most job duties. Supervision may be exercised over the work of other staff performing Occupational Therapy and clerical employees assigned to the service.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Licensed and currently registered by the New York State Education Department as an Occupational Therapist. Documented minimum of 1600 clock hours delivering occupational therapy services to children under five years of age in an early intervention, clinical pediatric, early childhood education program, which may include relevant experience obtained as part of a supervised educational program and/or clinical internship as a prerequisite for professional licensure provided that such experience must have included direct experience in delivering services to children with disabilities and their families. Demonstrated ability to work with both adults and children preferred.
