

Sullivan County Department of Public Health Services is seeking a  
**PUBLIC HEALTH PHYSICAL THERAPIST**

This is a professional position involving responsibility for evaluating, planning and providing physical therapy treatment to patients/clients in accordance with written prescription or referral from a physician who provides medical direction. The Physical Therapist is responsible for providing Physical Therapy to Certified Home Health Agency patients, Long Term patients and Early Intervention and Preschool Special Education children authorized to receive these services. Work is performed under general direction of the Director of Patient Services and/or a Supervising Public Health Nurse with wide leeway for independently performing most job duties. Supervision may be exercised over the work of Physical Therapy Assistants, Physical Therapy Aides and clerical employees assigned to the service.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Licensed and currently registered by the New York State Education Department as a Physical Therapist. Has documented minimum of 1600 clock hours delivering physical therapy services to children under five years of age in an early intervention, clinical pediatric, early childhood education program, which may include relevant experience obtained as part of a supervised educational program and/or clinical internship as a prerequisite for professional licensure provided that such experience must have included direct experience in delivering services to children with disabilities and their families. Experience providing services to both adults and children preferred.
