

The **Center for Workforce Development** is looking for **Crew Leaders** to work from July 2, 2018 through August 17, 2018 for a maximum 30 hours per week earning \$15 per hour.

This position involves responsibility for the day-to-day supervision and safety of youth participants in a summer youth employment and training program. The Crew Leader provides guidance and direction while leading participants in the performance of assigned job tasks.

Key competencies include the ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with young people from a variety of social, economic, cultural and ethnic backgrounds; ability to maintain records and prepare reports; ability to provide direction and leadership to program participants sensitivity to issues of cultural diversity; a desire to work with young adults and adolescents; good judgment; emotional maturity; initiative and resourcefulness; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents with a Bachelor's degree or higher; or
- (B) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents with an Associate's degree and two (2) years of experience in providing teaching support services, counseling, guidance counseling, or vocational/employment counseling; or
- (C) Possession of four years of experience as described in (B) above.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT(S) FOR APPOINTMENT: *Employees in this class will require access to transportation to meet field work requirements made in the ordinary course of business in a timely and efficient manner.*
