

Sullivan County is seeking an EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION

This position involves responsibility for directing a county-wide program concerned with eliminating discrimination and prejudice and fostering mutual understanding and self-respect among all racial, religious, age, ethnic and any other protected classes under state and federal law in Sullivan County. Work is performed under general supervision of the Sullivan County Human Rights Commission. Considerable leeway is allowed to independently perform most of the requirements of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: any combination of training and experience deemed acceptable by the Sullivan County Human Rights Commission.

Special Requirement for Appointment: Possession of an appropriate New York State Motor Vehicle Operator's License.

Please note: this is a part-time position – incumbent is expected to work 29 hours/week.
