The instructor designs, implements, and evaluates courses that ensure students acquire the knowledge and skills necessary for success in the care of pre-hospital treatment strictly adhering to policy, guidelines and regulations. The EMS instructor will report to the Deputy Commissioner of Public Safety for 911 & EMS.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- (A) Graduation from high school or possession of a high school equivalency diploma and two
(2) years of experience in EMS education as a CIC and/or CLI.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- (1) Must possess and maintain certification as a NYS EMT, AEMT, or Paramedic and*
- (2) possess and maintain NYS certification as a Certified Instructor Coordinator (CIC) and CPR instructor (AHA, ARC or HSI).*

*Candidate interview will include a 10-minute classroom presentation.
