

The **Sullivan County District Attorney's Office** is seeking to fill the following position:

DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S INVESTIGATOR

This position involves responsibility for the investigation of criminal complaints both independently and in conjunction with other law enforcement agencies. The work involves handling of evidence, evaluation of criminal complaints, interviewing witnesses, reviewing evidence with law enforcement agencies and preparation of investigative reports. Work is performed under general direction of the District Attorney with substantial leeway for independently conducting investigations and otherwise performing the duties of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Fifteen (15) years of full-time employment as a Police Officer having successfully completed the basic course for Police Officers approved by the Municipal Police Training Council, or its equivalent, and five (5) years of work experience in a criminal investigations division as a detective/investigator handling investigations, gathering evidence and/or conducting investigations in one of the following areas: narcotics, homicides, gang-related or domestic violence, missing persons, or economic fraud.

SPECIAL NOTE: Incumbents must be proficient in firearms and qualified to operate a pistol [must maintain semi-annual firearm proficiency qualification as directed by the Division of Criminal Justice Services].

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: Certification for Digital Forensics Analysis may be through either Cellebrite or Graykey, though Cellebrite is preferable.

NOTE: Your degree or credits must have been awarded by a college or university accredited by a regional, national, or specialized agency recognized as an accrediting agency by the U.S. Department of Education/U.S. Secretary of Education. If your degree or credits were awarded by an educational institution outside of the United States and its territories, you must provide independent verification of equivalency.
