COMMISSIONER OF PUBLIC SAFETY

This position is responsible for overseeing all operations and functions relating to the coordination and delivery of services as provided through the various public safety departments in County government. The incumbent will act as a liaison between the various public safety community organizations, agencies and the County government. Administrative oversight is exercised over the Emergency Control Center, Probation Department, Office of Emergency Management, and such other services as assigned by the County Manager. Supervision is exercised over administrative staff. Work is performed under direct supervision of the County Manager with considerable leeway for independently carrying out the requirements of the position.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

(A) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Master's Degree with major coursework in emergency management; public policy; planning; public or business administration, or a closely related field, with three (3) years of progressively responsible experience in emergency management; emergency response; homeland security; or public education, two (2) years of which must have involved training other agencies or individuals in emergency management or homeland security; **or**

(B) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with a Bachelor's Degree with major coursework in emergency management; public policy; planning; public or business administration, or a closely related field, with five (5) years of full time or equivalent experience as described in (A) above, two (2) years of which must have involved training other agencies or individuals in emergency management or homeland security; **or**

(C) Graduation from a regionally accredited college or university or one accredited by the New York State Board of Regents to grant degrees with an Associate's Degree with major coursework in emergency management; public policy; planning; public or business administration, or a closely related field, with seven (7) years of full time or equivalent experience as described in (A) above, two (2) years of which must have involved training other agencies or individuals in emergency management or homeland security.
