DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Assist in the installation of warning signs, paints centerlines, edgelines and crosswalks and does related work as required. This is manual work involved in all facets of the Department of Public Works traffic sign, and pavement marking programs. Incumbents of this class are required to carry out assignments under minimum supervision of a Sign Installer. May exercise minimum supervision over the work of Laborers.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: *The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.*

Assists in the installation of traffic warning signs;

Assists in marking centerlines, crosswalks, stop lines and edgelines;

Assists in fabricating traffic signs;

Assists in the installation of guide rails and barricades;

Assists in operating plowing and sanding equipment during snow and ice removal operations;

Assists in operating a variety of equipment, such as loaders, fork lifts, post drivers, etc., in installing signs;

Assists in painting bridges and buildings on occasion.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of traffic sign installation procedures and techniques; good knowledge of pavement marking equipment and procedures; ability to follow oral and written directions; ability to assist in the direction of work of Laborers; dependability; resourcefulness; initiative; and good physical condition.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One (1) year of experience in traffic sign installation and pavement marking.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT: Possession of an appropriate valid Motor Vehicle Operator's License.
