It requires a willingness to perform a variety of routine tasks. Chauffeurs will ordinarily operate a standard car or truck. Direct supervision in the way of specific assignments is received from a superior.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Operates a passenger car in the transportation of goods and meals for senior nutrition program;

May assist in serving or packaging meals at a senior citizen nutrition site, as needed;

May pick up and deliver meals in connection with a nutrition program; and

Delivers messages, supplies and materials;

<u>CHARACTERISTICS</u>: Good knowledge of the operation of a motor vehicle; good knowledge of New York State motor vehicle laws; good knowledge of the geography of the County; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written direction; mechanical aptitude; dependability; and courtesy.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

One year of experience in the operation of a motor vehicle.

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<u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS FOR APPOINTMENT</u>: Possession of an appropriate Motor Vehicle Driver's License at time of appointment.
