<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Employees in this class perform cleaning and minor maintenance tasks in a building, and operate a motor vehicle in transporting persons or materials and in running errands. Tasks are performed according to well established procedure. Direct supervision in the form of special assignments is received from a supervisor.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Sweeps and mops floors and stairs;

Dusts desks, woodwork, furniture and equipment;

Washes windows, walls, blackboards, sinks and other fixtures;

Empties waste baskets, collects and disposes of rubbish;

Clears snow and ice from walks:

May perform minor painting and other minor maintenance duties;

May perform a variety of minor groundskeeping duties such as operating a hand mower, trimming shrubs, raking leaves;

Operates a passenger car, station wagon, or van in the transportation of persons or materials;


Delivers messages, supplies and materials;

Cleans and makes minor repairs to vehicle operated.
