

CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT OPERATOR III

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Employees in this class perform manual duties in connection with the operation of automotive and construction equipment. This class is distinguished from that of Motor Equipment Operator and other Construction Equipment Operators on the basis that they are skilled in the operation of all assigned equipment including tractor trailer; routinely supervises a sub crew, and the entire operation in the absence of their supervisor. General directions are received from a superior, but employees are responsible for the safe and economical operation of their equipment or assigned tasks. Incumbents are responsible for coordinating and providing services for multiple operations.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: *The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.*

Skillfully operates a tractor trailer and all other solid waste, maintenance and construction equipment including hazardous materials;

Performs minor repairs and maintenance work on equipment;

Maintains vehicles assigned in a clean condition, including running lights;

Operates snow plows and other snow removal equipment;

Supervises a sub work crew regularly and the whole crew in the absence of a regular supervisor;

Report daily on the operating condition of vehicles and equipment to the Garage Superintendent and Supervisors;

Works well independently and gets along well with others;

Prepares all activity and other reports as required;

Performs other assigned tasks.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL CHARAC-

TERISTICS: Thorough knowledge of the operation of landfill maintenance and construction equipment; ability to make simple repairs to equipment; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; mechanical aptitude; industrious; dependability; and the ability to supervise.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Three (3) years of experience in the operation of a tractor trailer with demonstrated competency in operation of construction and/or landfill equipment.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT: Possession of a Commercial Driver's License with an "A" Classification (CDL-A).
