

**GOLF COURSE RANGER**

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: The work involves responsibility for patrolling a golf course to insure that players observe the rules and etiquette of the game and the rules of the golf course. An employee in this class may also regulate the starting of play. The work is performed under the general supervision of the Golf Professional. Supervision of others is not ordinarily a responsibility of the position.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Patrols golf course to regulate rates of play and otherwise assure that rules of golf etiquette are observed;

Checks and verifies that course users have paid fees;

Replaces divots and removes papers from golf course;

Starts golfers off first tee in proper sequence and with proper spacing;

Checks receipts to make sure that players have paid green and cart fees;

Assures that proper standard of conduct is maintained by all players on course.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND PERSONAL

CHARACTERISTICS: Working knowledge of the rules and etiquette of golf; ability to present and enforce simple rules of golf etiquette and conduct; ability to be courteous yet firm with the public; and dependability.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: None are required.
