<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: This position involves responsibility for assisting a Crew Leader with the day to day supervision of youth participants in a summer youth employment and training program. The Junior Crew Leader works under the general direction and leadership of a Crew Leader.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Assists the Crew Leader in the day to day supervision of youth;

Assists in the daily tracking of attendance;

Assists in making sure that youth participants are performing assigned job tasks in a safe manner; Assists in providing the educational components of the program;

- Assists in facilitating a positive relationship with worksite supervisors and providing information to supervisors concerning the program goals and objectives;
- Assists in maintaining records of daily attendance and takes appropriate action as attendance problems occur;
- Learns the SCANS foundation skills and competencies and provides assistance in developing assigned work tasks into educational experiences;

<u>CHARACTERISTICS</u>: Good knowledge of the scope of youth services available through the Summer Youth Program; working knowledge of other youth services available in the community; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with young people from a variety of social, economic, cultural, and ethnic backgrounds; ability to maintain records and prepare reports; ability to provide direction and leadership to program participants sensitivity to issues of cultural diversity; a desire to work with young adults and adolescents; good judgment; emotional
