May lead in performance of manual activities.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Operates a truck in connection with the removal of snow, debris and other refuse, and the transportation of sand, stone, asphalt, and other materials and supplies;

Drives workers to and from jobs;

Operates a snow plow, sander, water wagon, fuel service trucks, sweepers and utility vehicles;

May operate an air compressor in the breaking of pavements, and a chain saw in clearing brush and trimming trees;

Performs manual labor such as loading trucks, digging ditches, cleaning basins, erecting signs and fences;

Maintains vehicles assigned in a clean condition, including running lights;

Assists in performing a variety of automotive repair or maintenance tasks;

Operates welding and cutting equipment;

May infrequently operate other types of equipment.
