Makes minor repairs and adjustments to park equipment and park facilities, such as work related to

carpentry, painting and mechanical repairs;

Keeps various records of work performed;

Maintains records of supplies used;

Operates park equipment; green mowers, turf tractors with gang mowers, aerators, sprayers, etc.;

Performs work related to maintaining the greens as well as park grounds;

Performs minor maintenance, janitorial or related custodial duties.

TERISTICS: Ability to do semi-skilled work in various mechanical trades; clerical aptitude; ability
