

PARK MAINTENANCE PERSON

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is work requiring little technical skill, but willingness and ability to perform miscellaneous tasks related to the operation and repair of park equipment. Work is done in accordance with established procedures. Specific, frequent and detailed instructions are given to detailed and complex work.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES:

Makes minor repairs and adjustments to park equipment and park facilities, such as work related to carpentry, painting and mechanical repairs;

Keeps various records of work performed;

Maintains records of supplies used;

Operates park equipment; green mowers, turf tractors with gang mowers, aerators, sprayers, etc.;

Performs work related to maintaining the greens as well as park grounds;

Performs minor maintenance, janitorial or related custodial duties.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS: Ability to do semi-skilled work in various mechanical trades; clerical aptitude; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written direction; thoroughness; and dependability.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: One year of experience in general maintenance or building trades activities.
