TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Sweeps city streets;

Rolls out ash barrels from yards, houses, apartments or cellars to the street for loading on trucks;

Returns empty barrels from street to apartment house yards or cellars;

Loads ash barrels on trucks;

Distributes load on trucks;

Covers the garbage with tarpaulin;

Removes snow from streets, cleans snow from catch basins and corners and removes snow from around fire hydrants;

Sands icy streets.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARAC-

<u>TERISTICS</u>: Willingness to perform routine manual work; ability to lift heavy weights; and willingness to work under all weather conditions.

<u>MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS</u>: None is required, but some experience in heavy manual labor is desirable.
