SIGN INSTALLER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Installs traffic control and warning signs and paints center lines, edge lines and crosswalks; does related work as required. This is manual work involved in all facets of the Department of Public Works traffic sign, traffic light and pavement marking programs. Incumbents of this class are required to carry out assignments under a minimum of supervision. Supervision is exercised over the work of laborers.

<u>TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES</u>: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Installs traffic control and traffic warning signs;

Marks center lines, crosswalks, stop lines and edge lines;

Fabricates traffic signs;

Installs guard rails and barricades;

Operates plowing and sanding equipment during snow and ice removal operations;

Operates a variety of equipment, such as loaders, fork lifts, post drivers, et cetera, in installing signs;

Paints signs and buildings on occasion;

Performs other duties related to the Sign Shop.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL CHARAC-

<u>TERISTICS</u>: Good knowledge of traffic sign installation procedures and techniques; good knowledge of pavement marking equipment and procedures; ability to follow oral and written directions; ability to direct the work of laborers; dependability; resourcefulness; and initiative.

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MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Either:

- (A) Three (3) years of experience in traffic sign installation and pavement marking; or
- (B) One (1) year as Assistant Sign Installer

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT: Possession of a valid CDL-B NYS Motor

Vehicle Operator's License.
