

SKILLED ROAD MAINTAINER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This is primarily routine manual work involving responsibility for the accurate performance of a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the repair and maintenance of roads and bridges. Supervision may be exercised over the work of a crew of road maintainers.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: *The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.*

Performs rough carpentry in building forms for the pouring of concrete;

Performs semi-skilled concrete and stone masonry;

Leads in the mixing, pouring and finishing of concrete;

Supervises and coordinates the work of road maintainers in culvert installation, centerline striping, setting guide rails, paving and other operations;

Assists in the setting of reinforcing steel beams;

Performs a variety of skilled and semi-skilled tasks in the maintenance and repair of buildings.

FULL PERFORMANCE KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND PERSONAL

CHARACTERISTICS: Good knowledge of road and bridge construction and maintenance practices including safety precautions; working knowledge of carpentry and/or masonry; ability to understand and follow oral and written directions; ability to supervise and coordinate the work of others; ability to work outdoors in adverse weather; reliability; and sobriety.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Three (3) years of satisfactory experience in road construction and/or maintenance work, preferably including six (6) months experience in rough carpentry
