Work is performed under administrative direction. Supervision is exercised over Plant Operations, Plant Attendants, and other staff assigned to the facility.

TYPICAL WORK ACTIVITIES: The typical work activities listed below, while providing representative examples of the variety of work assignments in the title, do not describe any individual position. Incumbents in this title may perform some or all of the following, as well as other related activities not described.

Participates in the interviewing and selection of new staff;

Plans work, assigns work schedule, and supervises the work of staff assigned to the wastewater treatment plant;

Reviews operating records and logs to identify problems and makes recommendations to correct the problem;

Operates pumps, motors, compressor, machinery and equipment used in connection with the operation of the wastewater treatment facility;

Provides training and direction to operators, attendants, and other staff assigned to the facility;

Conducts inspections of machinery and equipment to determine that everything is functioning properly;

Conducts chemical tests and periodic analysis of wastewater;

Orders supplies and makes recommendations with respect to equipment purchases;

Maintains a variety of records, logs, and reports relating to operation of the wastewater treatment plant;

understand and record data from gauges, scales, and meters; and mechanical aptitude.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS: Graduation from high school or possession of an equivalency

diploma and three (3) years of experience in the operation of wastewater treatment plant facilities.
